Jack's Story Corner

Part two of my tour in Germany 1952, 53, 54.

When the Korean War wound down in July of '53 a lot of troops from that Theater were transferred to the various units stationed in Europe. Our Medical Company at



Sheridan Kaserne got seven of them.

Most of them, but not all, were career soldiers and therefore several years older than us. One of them was installed as the Motor Sergeant in our motor pool and three others were assigned as litter jeep drivers. The drivers were OK but that sergeant was a real dominating, arrogant S.O.B. He had to go! It took us almost six weeks to get him transferred to another outfit.

You see we had a very good relationship with Service Company next door and the Tankers across the street, they knew us by name and we knew them. Therefore we had access to a lot of stuff just for the asking, where normally a requisition form would have to be filled out in triplicate and than be signed by our motor officer before submitting. However this sergeant was a career man and a paper man and wanted everything done the army way, where we were almost all "short timers" with a little over six months to go before shipping out, and home. Anyway, about that time I spotted a B.M.W. motorcycle setting among some trees on the west end of our Kaserne, and fell in love with it. My bunk-



mate was an Austrian, spoke excellent Kraut and had been a German tanker during the Battle of the Bulge. He also had

raced motorcycles before being drafted into the German Army. So after he cast an eye upon my discovery we bought this bike from a guy who was about to rotate back to the states. We got the bike dirt cheap because it had a couple of teeth out of the ring gear and a broken piston. We hauled it to our motor pool and tore it all apart. The guys at Service Company welded new teeth on the ring gear and my bunk-mate took the engine pieces to a machine shop in downtown Augsburg where they bored the cylinders and fitted them with a couple of used but good pistons. We had it back together and running before the original owner shipped out. Tough! We even found a sidecar to hang on it. This sidecar was German military issue. It had an armored floor pan and a machine gun mount that we removed, but it was still terribly heavy. Anyway, now we had our own personal transportation from the motor pool to our barracks and back, while the U.S. Army supplied the fuel. I think just about everyone one in our motor pool used that bike to run errands and such.

One of the guys who came into our company from Korea had enough combat pay to buy a brand new 100 cc two cycle NSU motorcycle. What a sweet little machine compared to that big clippy BMW that we'd fixed up. However this guy hardly knew how to ride a bike. So when my bunk-mate and I offered to teach him if he'd let us take it for a spin around the kaserne he willingly agreed. Nice ride! However when my bunk-mate took his turn he had to show off his dare devil skills. Off he went, out of sight, but when he came back he was standing on the seat, with his hands on his hips as the bike pattered along about ten miles per hour. Around and around the parade grounds he went while the owner was about in tears begging for him to stop, get back down on the seat, whatever, before wrecking his brand new bike. Needless to say that was the last time we ever got to ride that bike. The guy taught himself how to ride.

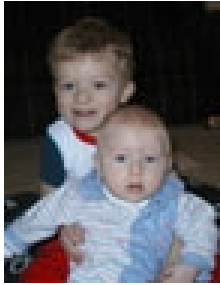

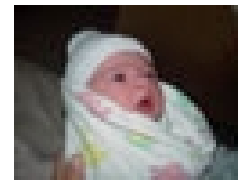

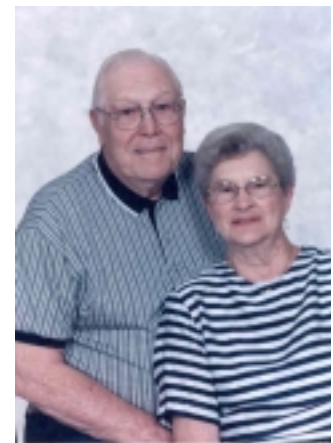

From the E-Mail Bag:

Commander Lee A. Gaul, USN, was called to active duty at the end of November. Commander Lee was deployed to Bahrain for two weeks orientation to several sites in Saudi Arabia and the Arab Emirates. His official destination became Camp Arifjan in Kuwait. At Camp Arifjan, Lee served with coalition forces as a Navy liaison officer and logistics specialist.



Camp Arifjan was (and is) a giant staging area in southern Kuwait where all the war materiel was off-loaded and—after the war—returned to ships for return to future destinations. Initially, things were strictly field living conditions which included living in tents. But things improved with the construction of “hardened” barracks. Outside of several missile attacks, no major military action took place at the camp. Sandstorms were major problems even when inside, the air becoming so heavy that it was “hardly worth breathing.”

At his last writing, Lee had completed 125 days of working 12 hr. days with no days off. He was able to find a Sunday Mass most of the time and said the chaplains said as many as eight Masses on the weekends to accommodate as many troops as possible.

Lee will be returning to Bahrain and should arrive back in the States about the middle of June. He will be deactivated at Great Lakes and return to his status in the Navy Reserves. To those of you who offered prayers for his safety and the welfare of all the troops in the Persian Gulf, Lee sends a grateful “Thank You!”

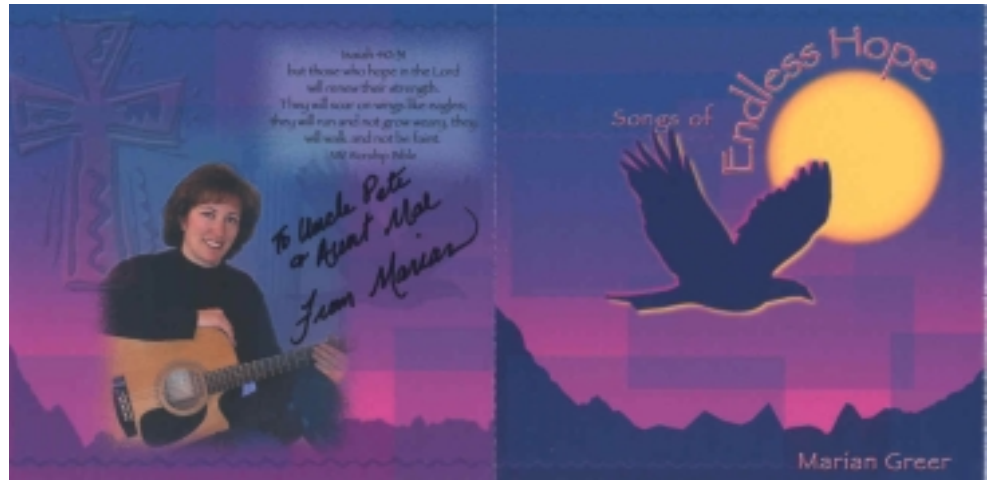
“Dear Pete and Mae, This CD is a gift to you to say thanks for all your work on the news letter over the years.
